Psalm 13:3




Eventually, "David ... fell asleep and was buried " Acts 13:36

David prayed regarding his own future resurrection: "I shall be satisfied when I awake in Your likeness."


Psalm 17:15

There is no such thing in Scripture as an "immortal soul", which lives on after the body dies....

Immortality is not something we are born with. God alone has immortality (1 Timothy 6:16).

Those in Christ will be granted immortality, which is only "put on" at resurrection. (1 Corinthians 15:54)

Our immortality relies on God resurrecting us, not something we have in ourselves.

> "I am (the) resurrection and (the) life ..." John 11:25


"When Christ our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory."
